Category:Education companies of the United States Category:Lawrence Technological University President Trump on Wednesday announced that he is directing the Veterans Affairs Department to hire 1,000 additional doctors to handle a backlog of medical complaints from veterans. The announcement comes as veterans wait weeks and months for care, as the VA has struggled to keep up with record-setting demand. "I think that I am going to make veterans problem-free for a long time to come, which is a big deal," Trump said during the signing. "That is big news and that is good news." Most veterans served in the military in the 1990s, an era when the VA was scrambling to keep up with the demand for benefits and care. In recent years, that backlog has grown exponentially. As of Monday, the VA said it was struggling to respond to more than 30,000 veterans every day. "We've been seeing a big surge of patients, especially in areas where we have physician shortage," Dr. Tracy Schaffer, the VA's national deputy undersecretary for health, told reporters Tuesday. "We've seen an increase in patient load, and we are working really hard to manage that load, but it is a real problem for us." In response to the backlog, the VA and the administration have spent more than \$12 million on televisions and video displays so veterans can watch their appointments online while waiting to see a doctor. The administration has launched a new electronic health-records system to try to cut down on processing time for veterans. But veterans' organizations have called those efforts insufficient. "The VA is leaving our veterans and their health literally at risk," said David Shulkin, the VA's former undersecretary for health, who resigned in March over the VA's handling of a veteran's medical complaint. On Monday, Shulkin — who was nominated to head the VA until Trump fired him — said that the department needs more doctors, nurses and other health care professionals as it tries to expedite care. The VA employs some 30,000 doctors and nurses, with 7,000 of those
